Today is Rose Sunday, one of our two refreshment Sundays during the church's penitential seasons. The Rose Sunday during Lent is also Mothering Sunday. The practice of visiting one's "mother church" has been practiced since the middle ages. It is a more than a thousand year old tradition to allow those in service the day off to go visit their mother churches (and their mothers).
