Happy Eastertide!

While I am away this Sunday, we will have a service of Solemn Holy Matins, or Morning Prayer. Elements of Morning and Evening Prayer are as old as the church. Daily prayer is an important part of the life of faithful Jewish people. Jesus. himself a faithful Jew, prayed every day. As the church grew and developed, readings from both the Old and New Testaments were added to the psalms to form the heart of this worship service. Canticles were also added. At the 10:00 service, those canticles will be sung. As I have written to you before, Morning and Evening Prayer were more musical services than the Eucharist was during the time of the early church. Leading these offices is not reserved to priests and bishops, as the Eucharist is. A trained and licensed lay person or a deacon may lead services of Morning Prayer as a community worship service. When Thomas Cranmer compiled the Book of Common Prayer, it was his hope that lay people would pray the daily office with their families at home. While even during more Puritanical times, the Eucharist never went away, Sunday Services of Solemn Morning Prayer were more common in many parishes around the country. Today's service may seem very new for some of you, and perhaps a reminder of long ago for others. Either way, I know God will be present in the building in all of your prayers.
